## **ENDORSEMENT**

- [1] This motion for appointment of a receiver was heard in motions court today. Counsel for all parties consenting or not opposing relief sought.
- [2] The Debtor parties are not represented and only Mr Yadwinder Singh attended, on his own, without counsel. He asked that the court give more time to retain counsel, with an aim of giving him a chance to get his business back on its feet. He told the Court that the interim receivership terms, and the actions of the CRA, have tied up his funds and prevented him from getting his employees back to work and his business running again.
- [3] The record did not support Mr. Singh's description of the cause of his current business challenges. I am satisfied that prior court attendances and the actions of the interim receiver, as the court's representative, have not occasioned, but rather have been necessary to respond to, the significant business troubles that Mr. Singh described. Mr. Singh pointed to no evidence that further delay in making the order sought would help his financial predicament.
